

## *Questions for Students*

### *Issues Related to Organization*

- What do you think this school wants you to know, understand, and be able to do after you graduate?
- Does the school function in an organized way?
- What activities does the school offer to make it more fun or interesting to be a student here?
- Are your parents involved in the school in any way? On a committee? Come to school as a volunteer? Work here? What about other adults? Business men and women?

### *Issues Related to Curriculum*

- Do teachers clearly communicate their expectations to you?
- Do you receive a course outline or syllabus at the start of each school year?

### *Issues Related to Instruction*

- Are your teachers clear about the content they expect you to learn? What happens if you're having difficulty?
- Is school challenging? Interesting? Too hard? Too easy?
- Do you ever do projects or presentations, work in groups, have guest speakers, or take field trips?
- Talk about homework.

### *Issues Related to Assessment*

- How do you find out how well you're doing in a class? What your grade is? Do you learn this early enough to improve?
- Can you get extra help if you're having difficulty?

### *Issues Related to Culture and Support*

- Is the school safe, clean, and orderly? Are the rules understood and enforced fairly?
- Does the school encourage diversity and multiculturalism?
- Tell us about how this school recognizes student accomplishments? Academic; athletic; artistic; community service; work preparation; other?
- Does the school offer any help for you if you're having difficulty academically? Personally?
